GNU GPLv3 and European Law

The first edition, in 2008 during the event « *Paris Capitale du Libre* » at Paris, was a great success :

- ✗ More than 20 speakers from the USA and Europe;
- ✗ More than 100 highly interested attendees.

« Terminology Open Source » et « Mutual development in the cloud ... and other experiences »

The second edition was held on December 9th 2009 in Brussels, hosted by the European Parliament ;

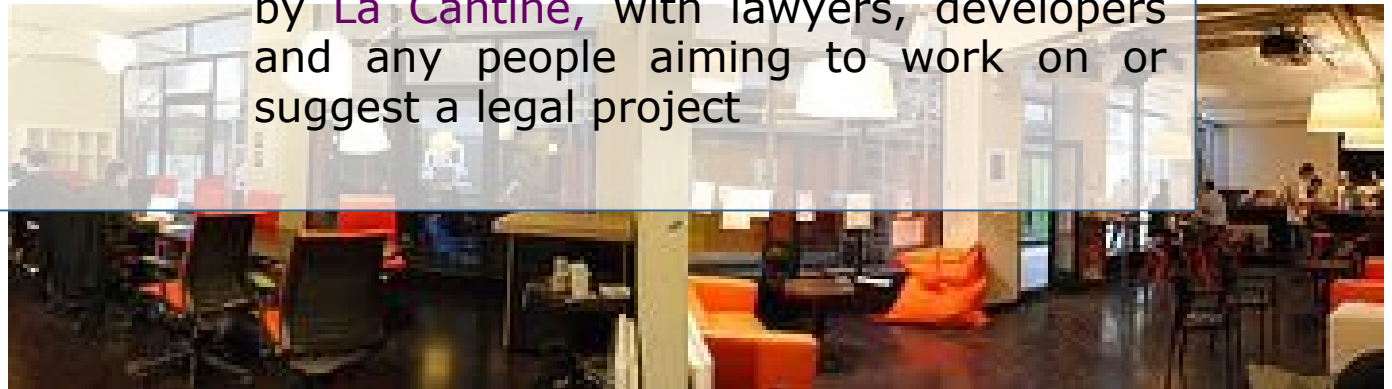
